October is Archaeology Month in Massachusetts! The Friends of the Rockland Memorial Library will host an event on Friday, October 19, 2012 from 3:30-4:45 p.m. in the community room. Judith Macioci, a former science teacher and now consultant to the Mass. Audubon Society, and Fred Robinson will present “**Buried Treasure: An Introduction to Archaeology.**” This program is for children ages 8 and up and adults. Come and experience the world of archaeology with hands on activities that will help you clue into the past. Examine artifacts from pre-Contact and historic periods, as well as Native American items. Learn about the science of archaeology and *bring your favorite artifact for identification.*
