SWAP SHOP REOPENING SPRING 2022

The Swap Shop at the Rockland Recycling Center (RRC) will re-open every Sunday in April 2022 from 8:30 – 11:30 . The Town of Rockland promotes the 5 R's: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose, Recycle all residents are encouraged to utilize the Swap Shop, to drop off gently used items or take items to repurpose at no charge. The attendants expect the Swap to be bustling during the Spring of 2022 as residents begin unloading their treasures.

As a reminder, accepted items must be in good and usable condition. The Attendants have the right of refusal.

Prohibited Items include mattresses, bulky and upholstered furniture, computers, paint, hazardous products, and rugs.

The Rockland Board of Health with the assistance of the Rockland Highway Department operates the Town's Recycling Area, which is located at 1000 Beech St. The facility is opened to Rockland residents with proper Town issued RRC stickers. Stickers for the RRC are issued at the Board of Health office with proper identification of residency and registration is required.
