Here are two revision drafts to your hearing notices. I fixed them as best I can.

On the project at 200 VFW Parkway, I am very unclear as to what is going on.

This site has a food and smoke shop and some type of restaurant on the first floor and these are the principal uses.

The applicant is proposing to have vehicle storage (maybe for his own personal cars) on the inside in the basement.

That additional use is **not** listed as a permitted use or permitted accessory use in that district and **I** suspect that this requires a use variance and not a special permit or section 6 finding.

I do not see any issue with his site maintenance and snow blower being stored in the building and that does not require any approvals.

Please check with building/zoning on this significant tissue.

I would recommend you and the applicant also check with the Fire Department. Storage of vehicles inside may also require significant changes to the walls and ceilings that may not be fire rated.
